ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

PAULA CARTER ENTERPRISES, INC.

SECRETARY OF STATE DIVISION OF CORPORATION

The undersigned acting as Incorporator & Initial Director of <u>PAULA CARTER</u>

<u>ENTERPRISES. INC.</u>, under the Florida Business Corporations Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be PAULA CARTER ENTERPRISES. INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be to engage in any and all lawful business under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 9895 S.W. 96th Street, Miami, FL 33176.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be ten thousand (10,000) shares of common stock having a par value of ten (\$0,10) cents per share. The consideration to be paid for each share shall be fixed by the board of directors and may be paid in whole or in part in cash or other

property, tangible or intangible, or in labor or services either actually performed for the corporation or in exchange for a written promise to perform services in the future, with a value, in the judgment of the directors, equivalent to or greater than the full par value of the shares.

ARTICLE V - PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

The corporation elects to have preemptive rights to acquire the corporation's unissued shares upon the decision of the board of directors to issue them.

ARTICLE VI - COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATION

The commencement of the Corporation will become effective <u>UPON THE FILING</u> of these Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE VII - RESIDENT AGENT AND ADDRESS

The street address of the registered office of the corporation is 7721 S.W. 62 Avenue, Suite 202, Miami, Florida 33143, and the name of the registered agent of this corporation at that address is Paul R. Sasso, Esquire.

ARTICLE VIII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The corporation shall have one initial (1) director. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time as provided in the bylaws, but shall never be less than one. The name and street address of the initial director member of the board of directors is:

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENTS

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner prescribed by law, and all rights conferred on shareholders are subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE XI - BYLAWS

The corporation's board of directors is specifically authorized from time to time to adopt bylaws, not inconsistent herewith or with shareholder agreements, restraining the elienation of shares of stock of this corporation and providing for the purchase or redemption by the corporation of its shares of stock.

ARTICLE XII - MEETINGS

Any action required or permitted by law to be taken at an annual or special meeting of shareholders may be taken without a meeting, without prior notice, and without a vote, if the action is taken by the holders of outstanding stock of each voting group entitled to vote thereon having not less than the minimum number of votes with respect to each voting group that would be necessary to authorize or take such action at a meeting at which all voting groups and shares entitled to vote thereon were present and voted. Prompt notice of the taking of the corporate action without a meeting by less than unanimous written consent shall be given to shareholders who have not consented in writing or who are not

entitled to vote on the action. Any action required or permitted by law to be taken at a board of directors' meeting or committee meeting may be taken without a meeting if the

action is taken and consented to in writing by all the members of the board or committee.

ARTICLE XIII - INDEMNIFICATION

This corporation shall indemnify every person who is or was threatened to be made

a party to any action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or

investigative by reason of the fact that he or she is or was a director or officer of this

corporation against expenses (including attorneys' fees), judgments, fines and amounts

paid in settlement, actually and reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with such

action, suit or proceeding, (except in cases involving gross negligence or willful misconduct

in the performance of his or her duties), to the full extent permitted by applicable law. Such

indemnification may, in the discretion of the board of directors, include advances of his or

her expenses in advance of final disposition subject to the provisions of applicable law. The

right of indemnification herein provided shall not be exclusive or other rights to which any

person may now or hereafter be

entitled as a matter of law.
