ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
TO
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
RAILROAD PROTECTIVE SERVICES, INC.

1. Article I of the Articles of Incorporation of Railroad Protective Services, Inc., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation"), is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"ARTICLE I. NAME

The name and mailing address of this corporation shall be RPS-SJC, Inc., 315 West Town Place, Suite 8, St. Augustine, Florida 32092."

2. The foregoing amendment was adopted by all of the directors and shareholders of the Corporation on October 2, 2014.

3. The foregoing amendment shall become effective when filed with the Secretary of State, State of Florida, and upon that date, the Corporation shall begin to use the name as provided in Article I, as hereby amended.
