**ARTICLE I
NAME**

The name of the Corporation is **JACQUELINE CAUSEY, P.A.** The address of the Corporation is 3106 West Tambay Avenue, Tampa, Florida 33611-1538.

**ARTICLE II
DURATION**

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

**ARTICLE III
PURPOSE**

The Corporation shall indemnify any Officer or Director, or any former Officer or Director, to the full extent permitted by law.




