## **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

#### ARTICLE - I

The name of this corporation is: AFFORDABLE ELECTRIC OF FLORIDA, INGO The principal office is this corporation is located at 5738 Pebble View, Milton, Florida 32583.

#### ARTICLE - II

The purpose of this corporation is for electrical contracting and to engage in any and all lawful business permitted under the laws of the State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 1,000 shares of \$1.00 par value common stock.

#### ARTICLE VIII - BYLAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal Bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the shareholders.

#### **ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENT**

This corporation reserves the right to amend, or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment to them, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.

#### ARTICLE X - RESTRICTIONS ON TRANSFER OF STOCK

In case a stockholder, his personal representatives, heirs, devisees, legatees, pledgee, assignee, receiver, trustee in bankruptcy or any other person holding under or in privity with any stockholder, desires to sell his shares of stock, he shall file notice in writing of such intention with the Secretary of the corporation, stating the price and terms upon which he desires to sell such stock, and unless the terms of such offer are accepted by the corporation within ten (10) days, it shall be deemed to have waived its privilege of purchasing. In the event that the corporation is legally unable to purchase such stock or otherwise waives its privilege of purchasing, the Secretary of the corporation shall mail a written notice to all of the remaining stockholders, by certified mail, return receipt requested, advising them of the terms of such offer, and unless the terms of such offer are accepted by any or all of the other stockholders within ten (10) days from the date of mailing such notice, they shall be deemed to have waived their privilege of purchasing, and the stockholders or the person in privity with him desiring to sell shall be at liberty to effect a sale upon the terms of such offer. No stockholder who has given notice pursuant to this Article, may thereafter sell such stock for a price or upon terms different than the offer contained in such notice, without again complying with the notice requirements of this Article. Neither the corporation, nor the remaining stockholders (collectively), may exercise their privilege of purchasing as to any shares of stock less than the total number of shares involved in such offer.

### **ARTICLE XI. INDEMNIFICATION**

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.
