ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

PURSUANT TO ARTICLE TWO OF THE STOCK CORPORATION LAW

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to Chapter 607 and/or Chapter 621, F.S. (Profit) Law of the State of Florida, do hereby certify:

FIRST: The name of the proposed corporation shall be FLORIDA DEEP FOUNDATIONS, INC.

SECOND: The purpose for which it is to be formed are:

To conduct and carry on the business of general contractors and builders; to design, plan, erect, construct, equip, alter, rebuild, remodel, improve and repair all kinds of houses building and other structures or parts thereof and works and excavations therefor; to perform all kinds of work in connection therewith; to employ mechanics laborers, artisans and workmen, and to make contracts and sub-contracts of work and materials; to make, purchase, and sell and deal in materials for the construction and equipment of buildings or of parts thereof or which may be conveniently dealt in connection with the
