Articles of Incorporation Of Estep Commercial Cleaning, Inc.

The undersigned incorporator to these articles of incorporation hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida as follows:

Article I Name and Address

The name of this corporation shall be Estep Commercial Cleaning, Inc. The street address of the corporation is: 12207 Spottswood Drive, Riverview, Ft. 33569

Article II Terms of Existence

This corporation shall have perpetual existence. Commencing upon filing of these articles of incorporation with the Florida Secretary of State.

Article in Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business.
