

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF JACK MORROW. INC.

1

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act. does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is JACK MORROW, INC.

ARTICLE II TERM OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

(a) To purchase, improve, develop, lease, exchange, sell, dispose of, and otherwise deal in real estate; to purchase, lease, build, construct, erect, occupy, and manage buildings of every kind and character whatsoever; to finance the purchase, improvement, development, and construction of land and buildings belonging to or to be acquired by this company, or any other person, firm, or corporation.

- (b) To own, operate, run, and manage the business of procuring, breeding, selling, or otherwise dealing in animals, birds, fish, and all supplies and equipment incidental thereto including but not limited to the operation of a feeding and/or breeding facility, farm, pet store, or several of the foregoing, and to do any and all other things that are incidental to the business herein described.
- (C) The corporation may transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporations Act.

ARTICLE IV AUTHORIZED SHARES

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation is authorized to issue is 1,000 shares of Capital Stock. Such shares shall be of a single class, and shall have a par value of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) per share and shall be deemed as Section 1244 Common Stock pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as amended or any other Section of the Internal Revenue Code treating such stock in the same manner as Section 1244 Common Stock as previously stated.

ARTICLE V INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

Having been named to accept service of process for the above stated corporation, at place designated in these Articles of

Incorporation. I hereby accept to act in this capacity, and agree to comply with the provisions of said Act relative to keeping open said office.

ARTICLE VI NUMBER OF DIRECTORS

The business of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of one or more members, the exact number to be determined from time to time in accordance with the By-Laws. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of one (1) Director.

ARTICLE IX

The Board of Directors shall adopt By-Laws for this corporation which may be amended. altered or repealed by the shareholders or directors in may manner permitted by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE X INDEMNIFICATION OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

- 1. The corporation shall indemnify any director or officer made a party or threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding:
- (a) Whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigation, other than one by or in the right of this corporation to procure a judgement in its favor, brought to impose a liability or penalty on such person for an act alleged to have been committed by such person in his capacity as director or officer of this corporation, or in his capacity as director, officer, employee, or agent of any other corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise which he has served at the request of this corporation, against judgements, fines, amounts paid in settlement and reasonable attorneys' fees, actually and necessarily incurred as a result of such action, suit or proceeding or any appeal therein, if such person acted in good faith in the reasonable belief that such action was in the best interest of this corporation, and in criminal actions or proceedings, without reasonable grounds for belief that such action was unlawful. The termination of such action, suit or proceeding, by judgement, order, settlement, conviction or

upon plea, of <u>nolo contendere</u> or its equivalent, shall not in itself create presumption that any such director or officer did not act in good faith in the reasonable belief that such action was in the best interests of the corporation or that he had reasonable grounds for belief that such action was unlawful.

- (b) By or in the right of this corporation to procure a judgement in its favor by reason of his being or having been a director or officer of this corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise which he served at the request of this corporation, against the reasonable expenses. including attorneys' fees, actually and necessarily incurred by him in connection with the defense or settlement of such action, or in connection with an appeal therein, if such person acted in good faith in the reasonable belief that such action was in the best interests of the corporation. Such person shall not be entitled to indemnification in relation to matters as to which such person has been adjudged to have been quilty of negligence or misconduct in the performance of his duty to the corporation unless and only to the extent that the Court. administrative agency, or investigation body before which such action, suit proceeding is held shall determine upon application, that despite the adjudication of liability but in view of all circumstances of the case, such person is fairly and reasonably entitled to indemnification for such expenses which tribunal shall deem proper.
- 2. Any indemnification under Section (1) shall be made by the corporation only as authorized in the specific case upon a determination that the amounts for which a director or officer seeks indemnification were

properly incurred and that such director or officer acted in good faith and in a manner he reasonably believed to be in the best interests of the corporation, and that, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, he had no reasonable ground for belief that such action was unlawful. Such determination shall be made either (a) by the Board of Directors by a majority vote of a quorum consisting of directors who were not parties to such action. suit or proceeding, or (b) if such quorum is not obtainable, or even if obtainable, a quorum consisting of shareholders who were not parties to such action, suit or proceeding,

3. The foregoing rights of indemnification shall not be deemed to limit in any way the powers of this corporation to indemnify under applicable law.

ARTICLE XI

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in may manner now or hereafter provided for by law, and all rights conferred upon stockholders hereunder are granted subject to this reservation.
