ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF INSURANCE CAPITAL, INC.

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation for profit under the Hayse of the RIDA State of Florida, hereby certifies:

FIRST: The name of the corporation shall be:

INSURANCE CAPITAL, INC.

SECOND: The place in Florida where its principal office is to be located is: 4928 N.W. 84th Road, Coral Springs, Florida 33067.

<u>THIRD</u>: The purpose for which the corporation is formed is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be formed under the laws of the State of Florida.

<u>FOURTH</u>: The maximum number of shares which the corporation is authorized to have outstanding is Fifteen Hundred (1,500) shares which shall consist of:
