# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned, hereby incorporate under Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, providing for the formation, liability, right, privileges and immunities of a closed corporation for profit.

### **ARTICLE I**

The name of this corporation shall be: STEINHATCHEE BOAT WORKS, INCORPORATED.

# ARTICLE II

**<u>PURPOSE</u>**: The corporation is formed for the following purposes:

(1) To purchase, receive by way of gift, subscribe for, invest in, and in all other ways accurire import, lease, possess, maintain, handle on consignment, own, hold for investment or other size ase, enjoy, exercise, operate, manage, conduct, perform, make, borrow, guarantee, contract in respect of trade and deal in, sell, exchange, let lend, export, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, importante, encumber, transfer, assign and in all other ways dispose of, design, develop, invent, improve, equip, repair, alter, fabricate, assemble, build, construct, operate, manufacture, plant, cultivate, produce, market, and in all other ways (whether like or unlike any of the foregoing), deal in and with property of every kind and character, real, personal, or mixed, tangible or intangible, wherever situated and however held, including, but not limited to, money, credits, choses in action, securities, stocks, bonds, warrants, script, certificates, debentures, mortgages, notes, commercial paper, and other obligations and evidences of interest in or indebtedness of any person, firm, or corporation, foreign or domestic, or of any government, or subdivision or agency thereof, documents of title, and accompanying rights, and every other kind and character of personal property, real property (improved or unimproved), and the products and avails thereof, and every character of interest and appurtenance thereof,

including, but not limited to, mineral, oil, gas, and water rights, all or any part of any going business and its incidents, franchises, subsidiaries, charters, concessions, grants, rights, powers or privileges, granted or conferred by any government or subdivision or agency thereof, and any interest in or part of any of the foregoing, and to exercise in respect thereof all of the rights, powers, privileges, and immunities of individual owners or holders thereof.

- (2) To hire and employ agents, servants, and employees, and to enter into agreements of employment and collective bargaining agreements, and to act as agent, contractor, trustee, factor, or otherwise, either, alone or in company with others.
- (3) To promote or aid in any manner, financially or otherwise, any person, firm, association, or corporation, and to guarantee contracts and other obligations.
- (4) To let concessions to others to do any of the things that this corporation is empowered to do, and to enter into, make, perform, and carry out, contracts and arrangements of every kind and character with any person, firm association, or corporation, or any government or authority or subdivision or agency thereof.
