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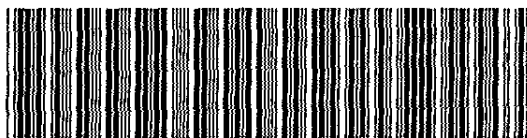

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I, the undersigned, being a natural person of legal age, do hereby desire to form a corporation under the laws of Florida and do hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

CLAJUL PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANTS, Inc.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III. GENERAL NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is: This corporation may engage in or transact any or all lawful activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States, the State of Florida, or any other state, country, territory, or nation.

To engage, contract and/or transact a development company of any kind. To buy, sell, exchange, trade and generally deal in real property, improved and unimproved of every class and description; to sell, buy mortgage, lease or otherwise acquire or dispose of any real property and take mortgages and assignment of mortgages upon the same; to make and obtain loans upon real estate, improved or unimproved, giving or taking evidence of indebtedness and securing the payment thereof by mortgage, trust, deed, pledge, or otherwise; to enter into contracts to buy or otherwise acquire for the purpose of holding or dispensing of the same, involving real property of any kind or nature and in connection therewith to enter into contracts with rental or leasing agents.

To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures. Notes, and other evidences of indebtedness and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business. The guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of capital stock or any bonds, securities or evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government and while owner of such stock, to exercise all the rights, powers, and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock. To engage in any other activity of business permitted under the laws of the United States and in this state.

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ARTICLE IV. CAPITOL STOCK

The maximum number of shares stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at one time is TWO THOUSAND (2,000) shares of Common Stock. The consideration to be paid for each share shall be issued as "small business corporation" stock in accordance with a plan or plans under the provisions of Section 1244 of the Internal revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

ARTICLE V. INITIAL OFFICERS/DIRECTORS

The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to, and not exclusive of all other rights to which each director, officer, employee or agent is entitled.

ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute.

ARTICLE X. PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation shall have the right to purchase his prorata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

ARTICLE XI. COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE
