ARTICLE 8: AMENDMENT

- (a) This Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.
- (b) In the event the ownership of shares of this Corporation shall be in any person, trust, corporation, estate or partnership who is not qualified under the provisions of Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, and here has been no voluntary transfer of stock, the Board of Directors and Shareholders shall have the power to amend these Articles of Incorporation to effect a change in the nature and purpose of the business authorized by these Articles of Incorporation, so that this Corporation shall have he power to conduct any business authorized by Chapter 607, Florida Statutes. ARTICLE 9: SEVERANCE AND TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT

If any officer, director, shareholder, agent or employee of this Corporation who has been rendering real estate services to the public becomes legally disqualified to render such professional services within this state, or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations upon his continued rendering of such professional services, then, in any such event, such person's office and/or employment with and/or financial interest in this Corporation shall cease forthwith; subject, however, to the provisions of Article 8(b) dealing with Amendments. Should any amendment be effected which changes the nature and purpose of this Corporation so that the restrictions of Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, do not apply, then the restriction of this Article shall not thereafter apply provided, however, that until such amendment is effected, such person shall render no professional services, shall hold no office, shall not serve on the Board of Directors of this Corporation and shall not have no financial interest in this Corporation except to receive payment for any stock owned and any other amounts that are lawfully due and owing by the Corporation.

Such stock shall be forthwith transferred, sold, purchased, pledged or redeemed at such price or value under such ter ms as shall be authorized as set forth in the Bylaws or
