ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FALLAHASSER, STORIGA

OF J C TAYLOR HOMES, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is J C TAYLOR HOMES, INC.

SECOND: The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized is to engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of this State of Florida. Further specific purposes for which the corporation is organized is to construct and/or remodel residential and commercial buildings.

FOURTH: <u>Authorized Shares.</u> The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have the authority to issue is 7500 shares of Capital Stock with a par value of \$1.00 per share.

Initial Issue. 500 shares of the Capital Stock of the corporation shall be issued for cash at a par value of \$1.00 per share.

Stated Capital. The sum of the par value of all shares of Capital Stock of the corporation that have been issued shall be capital of the corporation at any particular time.
