ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
TELEVISION CONFERENCING CORPORATION

The undersigned subscribers to these articles of incorporation, natural persons, competent to contract, hereby form a corporation for profit under Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I


**ARTICLE XV


