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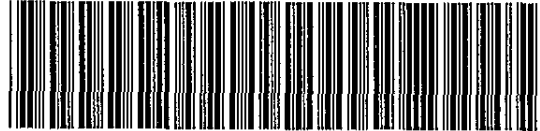

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

Pursuant to Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, the undersigned, being a natural person who is licensed to practice engineering in the State of Florida, hereby acts as an incorporator in adopting and filing the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of organizing a professional corporation under the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act.

ARTICLE I
(Name)

The name of the Corporation ("Corporation") is Garcia Bridge Engineers, P.A.

ARTICLE II
(Principal Office)

ARTICLE III

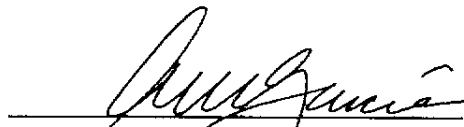
ARTICLE VI

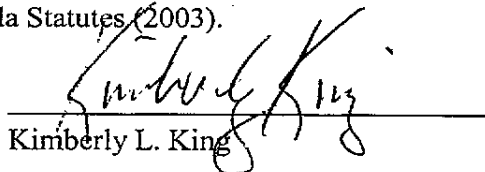
