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ARTICLES OF A PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION

of

BARBARA JACKSON LYONS, P.A.

The undersigned subscribers to these articles of a professional association, natural persons competent to contract, hereby forms a professional association under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of the professional association shall be:

The principal place of business and mailing address of this professional association shall be:

The President and Board of Director members may from time to time move the office to any other place in Florida.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this professional association is to perform real estates sale services to various individuals in need of its services.

To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services of every class, kind, and description; except that it is not conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, insurance, surety, express, railroad, canal, telegraph, telephone or cemetery company, a building and loan association, mutual fire insurance association, cooperative association, fraternal benefit society, state fair or exposition.

To conduct business in, have one or more offices in, and buy, hold, mortgage, sell, convey, lease, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property, including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademarks, and licenses, in the State of Florida and in all other states and countries.

To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.

To purchase the assets of any other professional association and engage in the same or other character of business.

To endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other professional association of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.

To become guarantor or surety for any other person, firm or professional association for any purpose or transaction whatsoever.

To make gifts of its property or cash, either to charitable organizations or otherwise, when deemed in the interest of the professional association.

To adopt such pension, profit sharing, stock option, and deferred compensation plans for officers, employees and directors and to grant such stock options to officers, employees, directors and others as the Board of Directors may deem to be in the interest of the professional association.

To have and exercise all of the powers now or to hereafter conferred upon professional associations by the statutes and laws of the State of Florida.

All of the foregoing in this article shall be construed as both objects and powers. The enumeration of specific powers and purposes is not intended to restrict or limit in any way the powers or purposes of this professional association.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock which this professional association is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is:

ARTICLE IV. TERM

ARTICLE VII. MISCELLANEOUS

This professional association shall have the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these articles of professional association and any right conferred upon the stockholders is subject to this provision.

Ownership of stock in this professional association shall not be required to make any person eligible to hold office or to become a director in this professional association.

The stockholders, or any two or more of them, may by agreement recorded in the minute book of this professional association impose such restrictions on the sale, transfer or encumbrance of the stock in this professional association owned by the subscribers to such agreement as they may see fit. The by-laws of this professional association may impose any restrictions on the sale, transfer or encumbrance of the stock of this professional association as may be lawful under the statutes and laws of the State of Florida when such by-law is adopted and amended.

Any subscriber or stockholder present at any meeting, either in person or by proxy, and any director present at any meeting of the Board of Directors shall be conclusively deemed to have received proper notice of such meeting unless he shall make objection at such meeting to any defect or insufficiency of notice.

Any contract or other transaction between the professional association and one or more of its directors, or between the professional association and any firm of which one or more of its directors are members or employees, or in which they are interested, or between the professional association and any corporation or association of which one or more of its directors are shareholders, members, directors, officers, or employees, or in which they are interested, shall be valid for all purposes

notwithstanding the presence of such director or directors at the meeting of the Board of Directors of the professional association, which acts upon, or in reference to, such contract or transaction, and notwithstanding his or their participation in such action, if the fact of such interest shall be disclosed or known to the Board of Directors and the Board of Directors shall, nevertheless, authorize, approve or ratify such contract or transaction by a vote of a majority of the directors present, such interest director or directors to be counted in determining whether a quorum is present, but not to be counted in calculating the majority necessary to carry such vote. These provisions shall not be construed to invalidate any contract or other transaction, which would otherwise be valid under the common law and statutory law applicable thereto.

The Board of Directors is hereby specifically authorized to make provisions for reasonable compensation to its members for their services as Directors, and to fix the basis and conditions upon which such compensation shall be paid. Any director of the professional association may also serve the professional association in any other capacity and receive compensation therefor in any form.

ARTICLE X. INDEMNITY

This professional association is authorized to indemnify any director, officer, or employee, or former director, officer or employee of this professional association, or any person who may have served at its request as a director, officer or employee of another professional association in which it owns shares of capital stock, or of which it is a creditor, against expenses actually and necessarily incurred by him in connection with the defense of any action, suit or proceeding in which he is made a party by reason of being or having been such director, officer, or employee, except in relation to matters as to which he shall be adjudged in such action, suite or proceeding to be liable for negligence or misconduct in the performance of duty. This professional association may also reimburse to any director, officer, or employee the reasonable costs of settlement of any such action, suit or proceeding, if it shall be found by a majority of a committee composed of the directors of this professional association not involved in the matter in controversy (whether or not a quorum) that it was to the interests of this

professional association that such settlement be made and that such director, officer or employee was not guilty of negligence or misconduct. Such indemnification or reimbursement shall not preclude such director, officer or employee from exercising any rights to which he may be entitled under the by-laws or otherwise.

ARTICLE XI. AMENDMENT

These articles of professional association may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved by the Board of Directors, proposed by them to the stockholders, and approved at a stockholder's meeting by **FIFTY (50) PERCENT** of the stock entitled to vote thereon, unless all the directors and all the stockholders sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of these articles of professional association be made.
