Pursuant to Section 607.1006, Florida Statutes, the Articles of Incorporation AmericanFirst Bank are hereby amended as follows:

Article III of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended by deleting the FIRST: text thereof in its entirety and substituting the following in lieu thereof:

The total number of shares authorized to be issued by the corporation shall be 10,000,000 shares. Such shares shall be of a single class of common stock and shall have a par value of \$5.00 per share.

The foregoing amendment was adopted by the holders of all the outstanding SECOND: shares of common stock, being the sole voting group entitled to vote on the amendment, on April 15, 2009 and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval by the holders of common stock.
