ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF GILMORE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC.

We the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose R_{Y} of forming a Corporation for profit under the Laws of the State of Florida, and S_{EE} , $F_{LOR_{i}}$ in accordance with the following Articles of Incorporation.

T

The names of the Corporation shall be:

GILMORE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC.

and its principal place of business shall be 1920 Libby Court, Holiday, Pasco County, Florida, with the right to change and move said principal place of business within or without the State of Florida as the Board of Directors may from time to time deem proper.
