

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

The undersigned incorporator hereby files these Articles of Incorporation in order to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

Name and Principal Office of Corporation

The name of this Corporation shall be Field Examiners, Inc. The initial street address of the Corporation shall be 16518 S.W. 36 Street, Miramar, Florida 33027.

ARTICLE II

Nature of Business
