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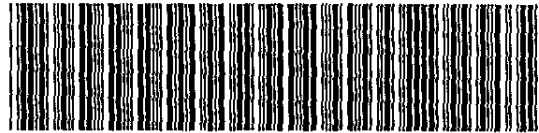

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF**

2ND LINE CLOTHING, INC.

Adopted by the shareholders on November 3, 2004

BY THESE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION the incorporators form a corporation under Florida law.

ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of this corporation is: 2ND LINE CLOTHING, INC.

ARTICLE 2: TERM

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE 3: PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

- a. To operate as a corporation for profit pursuant to Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE 4: SHARES

There are 1000 shares of stock within this business, which will be divided as following: Paula Black, Owner: 500 shares and Byron Wamley, Owner: 500 shares.

ARTICLE 5: POWERS

This corporation shall have the following powers:

All of the law and statutory powers of a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida which are not in conflict with the terms of these Articles.

To enter onto, make, establish and enforce, bylaws, and contracts to carry out the purposes if the corporation.

To own, purchase, sell, mortgage, lease, administer, manage, operate, maintain, improve, repair and/or replace real and personal property.

To hold funds for the exclusive benefit of the Members of this corporation as set forth in these Articles and as provided in the Bylaws.
