ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF AB EXPORT, INC.

I, the undersigned, desiring to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, do hereby declare as follows:

ARTICLE 1

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: AB EXPORT, INC.

ARTICLE II BUSINESS AND POWERS

The corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of United States and of the state of Florida.

ARTICLE III STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock which this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be 1,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share The capital stock may be paid for in property, labor or services at a just valuation, to be fixed by the incorporators or by the directors at a meeting called for such purposes or at the organization meeting.
