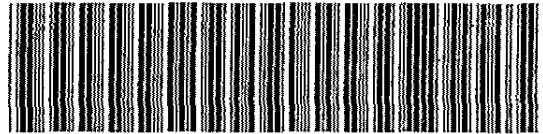

The undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida:

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the corporation is **SHEPHERD BP, INC.**

**ARTICLE II - Principal Office
and Mailing Address of the Corporation**

The address of the principal office of the corporation is 1717 Shepherd Road, Lakeland, Florida 33811, and its mailing address is the same.

ARTICLE III - Commencement and Duration

The corporation is to commence its corporate existence effective immediately, and shall exist perpetually thereafter until dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE IV - Purpose

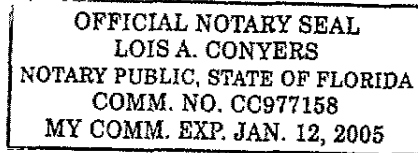

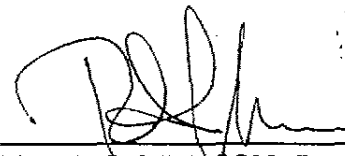
