Dear Ms. Shoffstall:

This letter follows up on our conversation this morning. Please find enclosed a copy of the Amended Final Default Judgment in the above-styled case. The State had filed this civil RICO suit against the Defendants arising from their illegal prescription-drug diversion ring.

In addition to forfeiting numerous items of property and cash to the State, the Judgment also orders the dissolution of the Defendants' corporations. One of these, Arteaga Courier Services Corp., is a Florida corporation.

In speaking with your office, I realized that there may be some confusion over the Judgment's phrasing with regard to who is responsible for dissolving the corporation. I was the one who drafted the Judgment, which the Judge signed without edits. My intent was that the various state entities responsible for the corporations—the Division of Corporations in this instance—would be the ones to dissolve them. Given the adversarial nature of this action, we could not have relied on the Defendants to do so, which only would have led to additional litigation if they failed to comply.

There would also be little reason to dissolve the corporations in a roundabout way through the Defendants when the State could do it directly. Contrast this with numbered paragraph #1 of the Judgment, which does specifically command the Defendants to cease engaging in the illegal activity. Had that also been my intent for the dissolution, I would have included similar language in paragraph #2.

I hope that this explanation will be sufficient to allow the Division to permanently dissolve Arteaga Services Corp. Although it is currently listed as inactive, we would not want Mr. Arteaga to be able to reinstate it.

AMENDED FINAL DEFAULT JUDGMENT

This matter came before the Court on Plaintiff STATE OF FLORIDA, OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, DEPARTMENT OF LEGAL AFFAIRS' Motion for Default Final Judgment and Motion to Amend Final Default Judgment.

Hearing on the Motion for Default Final Judgment was held on June 10, 2015, and was attended by counsel for Plaintiff. Notice of the hearing was furnished to the defaulted Defendants, who did not appear. Upon careful review of the pleadings and record, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Court makes the following findings:

Plaintiff seeks the forfeiture of a number of bank accounts, vehicles and vessels, cash and personal property purchased with profits from Defendants' illegal racketeering activities, which included trafficking in contraband prescription drugs, money laundering and engaging in an organized scheme to defraud, all in violation of Florida's RICO Act, Fla. Stat. § 895.01, et seq.

On June 17, 2013, the Court granted Plaintiff's first Emergency Ex Parte Motion for Injunctive Relief, permitting Plaintiff to seize the various bank accounts and personal property. On July 3, 2013, the Court granted Plaintiff's second Emergency Ex Parte Motion for Injunctive Relief,

A TRUE COPY CERTIFICATION ON LAST PAGE MARVEY RUVIN, CLERK OF COURTS permitting Plaintiff to seize an 11-foot Avon dinghy. On August 26, 2013, the Court granted Plaintiff's third Emergency Ex Parte Motion for Injunctive Relief, permitting Plaintiff to seize two checks that were proceeds from Defendants' criminal enterprise.

All Defendants were properly served with Plaintiff's Amended Complaint. On April 8, 2015, defaults were entered against the Defendants for their failure to serve or file any pleading or papers in response. By virtue of their defaults, Defendants have admitted all well-pled allegations against them. Fiera.com, Inc. v. DigiCast New Media Group, Inc., 837 So. 2d 451, 452 (Fla. 3d DCA 2002).

All conditions precedent to the entry of a Final Judgment of Forfeiture have occurred or have been performed. There is clear and convincing evidence that the subject property was used or intended to be used in violation of the Florida RICO Act, Fla. Stat. Ch. 895.01, et seq.

Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

- Defendants are permanently enjoined from engaging in the same or similar type of conduct as
 described in the Amended Complaint.
- 2. Defendants' business entities listed below are ordered to be dissolved:
