

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be:

JAMES A HUBBART, P.A.

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

To engage in services and activities associated with Real Estate and decision-making in the public and private sector.
