ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MAZAL & MAZAL, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be MAZAL & MAZAL, INC.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS
