ARTICLE I-NAME

The name of this professional corporation will be FRANK KREGLER, P.A.

ARTICLE II-DURATION

The duration of the professional corporation will be perpetual.

ARTICLE III-PURPOSE

The professional corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business under Chapters 607 and 621, Florida Statutes, as amended from time to time.

ARTICLE IV-AUTHORIZED STOCK

The professional corporation is authorized to issue Five Thousand (5,000) shares of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value common stock.

ARTICLE V-INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

The name of the initial registered agent of the professional corporation is Frank Kregler. The street address of the initial registered office of the professional corporation for service of process shall be: 3875 Crescent Cove Place, Tarpon Springs, FL 34688.

ARTICLE VI-PROFESSIONAL PURPOSE

The professional corporation is formed for the purpose of providing real estate related services to the public and therefore no shareholder may be permitted to sell or transfer ownership interest in this professional corporation except to another

professional corporation, professional LLC, or an individual, each of whom must be duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render the same specific professional services as those for which this professional corporation is organized. No person shall become a shareholder of this professional corporation, unless the person is a professional corporation, a professional LLC, or an individual, each of whom must be duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render the same specific professional services as those for which this professional corporation is organized, in accordance with Chapters 607 and 621 Florida Statutes, as amended from time to time.

ARTICLE VII—INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The professional corporation initially shall have one (1) director. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with the bylaws, but the number of directors shall not be less than one person at any time. ARTICLE X-BY LAWS

ARTICLE XIII-AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES

The professional corporation reserves the rights to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provision or provisions contained in these Articles or Incorporation, or any amendment thereto, in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida as amended from time to time. All rights conferred upon the shareholder of the corporation are granted subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE XIV-COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The date of commencement of corporate existence for the above-named professional corporation shall be the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

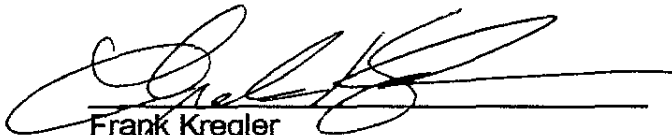
