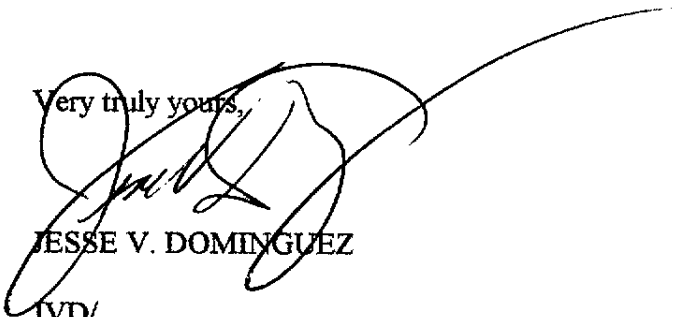

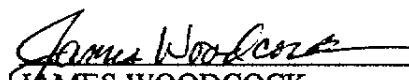

2. Sale of Corporate assets.

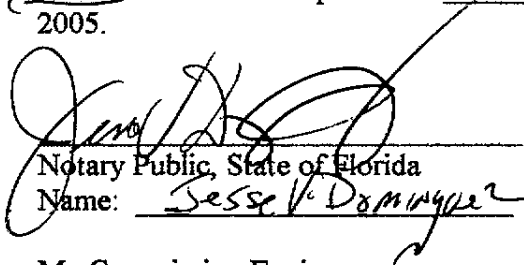

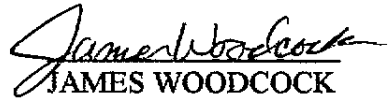
