ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT  
OF  
CALKINS MEDIA OF TALLAHASSEE, INC.

SECRETARY OF STATE  
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The Articles of Incorporation of Calkins Media of Tallahassee, Inc. (the "Corporation"), a Florida corporation, formed on July 21, 2005, and assigned document number P05000102337, are hereby amended by striking Article 3 in its entirety and by substituting in its place the following:

3. Authorized Shares. The Corporation is authorized to issue 10,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$.01 per share. No share shall be issued except upon payment to the Corporation of the par value of the share in cash or other consideration permitted by law as payment for shares.

The amendment was approved and adopted by written consent of the shareholders and directors of the corporation on November 9, 2006. The number of votes cast for the amendment by the shareholders was sufficient for approval.
