ARTICLES OF CORPORATION

OF

Blue Line Equipment, Inc.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is:

Blue Line Equipment, Inc.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation is to exist perpetually. It shall commence its existence upon filing.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This exponentian is organized for the purpose of transacting and conducting any and all business permitted under the laws of the United States of America and the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue $1,000\,$ shares of no par value common stock.

When payment of the consideration for which shares are to be issued shall have been received by the corporation, such shares shall be deemed to be fully paid and non-assessable.

ARTICLE V - PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he/she already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.
