ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, licensed or otherwise legally authorized to practice medicine by and within the State of Florida, hereby acting as incorporators for the purpose of forming a professional service corporation for profit, by virtue of the provisions of Chapters 621 and 607, Florida Statutes, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1: NAME AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE 2: DURATION

This Corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing as of the date of acceptance and filing of these Articles by the Secretary of State of Florida.

ARTICLE 3: PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized for the following purposes:

Said classes of stock shall be identical in all respects except that shareholders owning Class B Non-Voting Common stock shall have no voting rights of any kind or nature whatsoever. Shares of the Corporation's stock and certificates therefor shall be issued only to doctors in good standing and duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized within the State of Florida
