ARTICLE ONE - NAME

ARTICLE TWO - DURATION

ARTICLE THREE - PURPOSE

The purpose for which this is organized shall be to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under Florida Business Corporation Act to be transacted, promoted or carried on are:

To engage in the promotion and transportation services and any and all lawful business in the State of Florida, including but not limited to:

The promotion and management of To purchase, receive by way of gift, subscribe for, invest in, and all other ways acquire, invest lease, possess, maintain, handle on consignment, own, hold for investment or otherwise use, enjoy, operate, exercise, manage, conduct, perform, make, borrow, guarantee, contract in respect of, trade and deal in, sell, exchange, let, lend, export, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, hypothecate, encumber, transfer, assign, and in all other ways dispose of, design, develop, invent, improve, equip, repair, alter, fabricate, assemble, build, construct, operate, manufacture, produce, market, and in all other ways (whether like or unlike the foregoing), deal in and with property of every kind and character, real, personal or mixed, tangible and intangible, wherever situated and however held, including but not limited to, money, credits, chooses in action, securities, stocks, bonds, warrants, scripts, certificates, debentures, mortgages, notes, commercial paper and other obligations and evidences of interest in or indebtedness of any person, firm or corporation, foreign or domestic, or of any government or subdivision or agency thereof, documents of title, and accompanying rights, and every other kind and character of personal property (improved and unimproved), and the products and avails thereof, and every character of interest therein and appurtenance thereto, including, but not limited to, mineral, oil, gas, and water rights, all or any part of any going business and its incidents, franchises, subsidiaries, charters, concessions, grants, rights, powers or privileges, granted or conferred by any

government or subdivision or agency thereof, any interest in or part of any of the foregoing, and to exercise in respect thereof all of the rights, powers, privileges, and immunities of individual owners or holders thereof:

To hire and employ agents, servants and employees, and to enter into agreements of employment and collective bargaining agreements, and to act as agent, contractor, trustee, factor or otherwise, either alone or in company with others:

To promote or aid in any manner, financially or otherwise, any person, firm, association or proporation, and to guarantee contracts and other obligations;


ARTICLE THIRTEEN - BOARD OF DIRECTORS


