NAME

ARTICLE II

NATURE OF CORPORATE BUSINESS

To establish, maintain, conduct, and operate fish markets, and stores of every kind, nature, and description; to purchase, buy, sell, exchange, grow, produce, manufacture, process, market, export, import, handle, store, distribute, and otherwise generally deal in any and all articles of food, food products, household products, groceries, dairy products, beverages of all kind. To produce, raise, catch, take, process, and deal in and with fish, sea foods, and maritime products of every nature. To acquire, construct, maintain, operate, buy, sell, and deal in stores selling such goods, wares, and merchandise; to acquire, construct, establish, maintain, operate, or sell or dispose of factories, plants, warehouses, dairy plants, creameries, machinery and equipment, markets, stores, depots, and gathering and delivery routes and systems for such purposes.

To borrow money and contract debts; to make, issue and dispose of bonds, debentures, notes and other obligations, secured or unsecured; and to make any lawful contract of guaranty, suretyship, or of any kind whatsoever in connection with, or in aid of any corporation or other organizations any of whose this Corporation owns or in which this Corporation has an interest; to secure contracts, obligations, and liabilities or any thereof, in whole or in part, by mortgage, deed of trust, creation of security interest in, pledge, or other lien, upon any or all of the property of this Corporation wheresoever situated, acquired, or to be acquired.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed as and shall be powers as well as purposes, and all matters expressed in each clause shall, unless otherwise herein expressly provided, be in no wise limited by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause but shall be regarded as independent powers and purposes; and the enumeration of specific powers and purposes shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the meaning of general terms of the general powers of this Corporation, nor shall the expression of one thing be deemed to exclude another not expressed, although it be of like nature.
