ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation is STUDENT FINANCIAL RELIEF, INC.

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE AND NATURE OF BUSINESS

The purpose of the corporation and the nature of its business are as follows:

A. Financial Consultation Services

- 1. To provide dissemination of information to former collegiate borrowers and potential students on procedures and processes for college funding;
- 2. To advice client of monetary options for financial support of higher learning opportunities;
- 3. To counsel on matters concerning lender deferment, forbearance and consolidation and forgiveness options.

B. Financial Service Administration
