Articles of Incorporation
Of
STUDENT FINANCIAL RELIEF, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I:
NAME

The name of the corporation is **STUDENT FINANCIAL RELIEF, INC.**

ARTICLE II:
PURPOSE AND NATURE OF BUSINESS

The purpose of the corporation and the nature of its business are as follows:

A. Financial Consultation Services

1. To provide dissemination of information to former collegiate borrowers and potential students on procedures and processes for college funding;
2. To advice client of monetary options for financial support of higher learning opportunities;
3. To counsel on matters concerning lender deferment, forbearance and consolidation and forgiveness options.

B. Financial Service Administration

1. The services of this Corporation which consist of preparation of financial packages for prospective clients in order to secure loan consolidation.
2. To market the federal family educational loan program and encourage exercise of borrower's rights in accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965.
3. To do every other act incidental thereto which is, or may hereinafter, be lawful for the Corporation to do or exercise under laws of the State of Florida, the Professional Rules of Conduct or the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation.

C. Related Business Activities

1. To generally engage in and carry on any business incidental thereto;
2. To do any and all other things and to exercise any and all other powers which a Florida professional legal service corporation, by authority and by law, does or exercises;

3. To construct, lease, purchase or otherwise acquire real estate and personal property of any nature, or any interest, therein, without limit as to amount or value, reasonably necessary or convenient for effecting or furthering any or all of the purposes and powers, including ownership of real estate and intangible property, entering into contracts, investment in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds; and
4. To carry on any activity necessary or incidental to the accomplishment or furtherance of the purpose of the corporation, all in accordance with the provision of F.S. Chapter 621.

ARTICLE III: CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of stock that the Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 100 shares, having a par value of \$1.00 per share. Such shares shall be of a single class of common stock. None of the shares of the Corporation may be issued to anyone other than an individual who is duly licensed to practice law in the State of Florida and is an active member of the law in good standing.

ARTICLE IV: DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V: ADDRESS AND AGENT

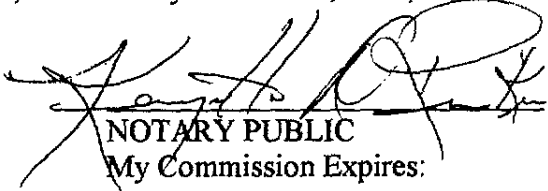

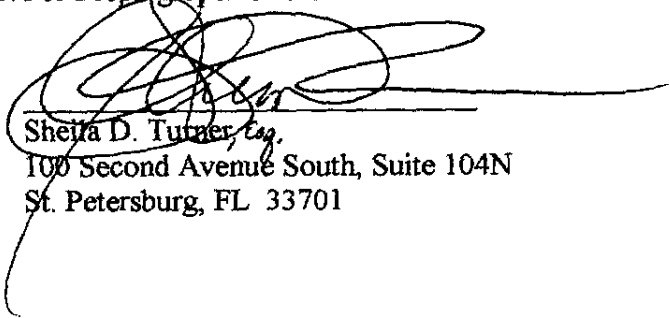
