BY THESE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION the incorporator forms a corporation for profit under Florida law.

# ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be M & R MIDDLETON INCORPORATED hereinafter referred to as the Corporation. The physical address is 34624 SW 187th Court, Homestead, Florida 33034 and main mailing address is P.O. Box 343561, Florida City, Florida 33034

#### ARTICLE II
