ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation is BAUER MARTINEZ AND ASSOCIATES, INC.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

TERM

The term of existence of this corporation is perpetual.

PURPOSE

The total number of shares of Class B stock that the corporation may issue is Seven Thousand Five Hundred (7,500) shares of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value per share. Class B stock has no voting rights. Each share of Class B stock shall be entitled to share equally in dividends declared and paid by the corporation from legally available funds. In the case of voluntary or involuntary liquidation, distribution or sale of assets, dissolution or winding up of the corporation, Class B shareholders are entitled to receive a pro rata share, with Class A shareholders, of the amount distributed.

ARTICLE VI

DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have one (1) Director initially. The number of Directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the Bylaws but shall never be less than one
