ARTICLE II Business and Purposes

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation (hereinafter, "Corporation"), or the objects or purposes of this Corporation, shall be as follows:

- (a) to engage in the business of manufacturing, wholesaling, retailing and marketing of all lines of promotional goods and items, including but not limited to clothing, shirts, slacks, caps, hats, other textile products, and any and all other related items, products, or goods:
- (b) to engage in any lawful enterprise, whether commercial, industrial or agricultural, calculated or designed to be profitable to the Corporation;
- (c) to generally engage in, do and perform any enterprise, act, or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform;
- (d) to manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and transfer or otherwise dispose of, or invest, trade, deal in and deal with, goods, wares, merchandise and real and personal property of every class and description;

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(e) to purchase, lease and hold real and personal property (including, any and all estates

and interests therein, and chooses in action secured thereby); to improve, manage, operate, sell,

mortgage, lease and otherwise dispose of any property; to loan money upon such property and to

take mortgages and assignments of mortgages on the same; and, to transact all or any other

business which may be necessary, incidental or proper to the exercise of any or all of the aforesaid

purposes of this Corporation;

(f) to borrow money and contract debts when necessary for the transaction of its business

or for the exercise of its corporate rights, privileges or franchises, or for any other lawful purposes;

to issue bonds, promissory notes, bills of exchange, debentures and other obligations and

evidences of indebtedness payable at a specified time or times secured by mortgage or otherwise;

(g) to quarantee, purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise

dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds issued by, or evidences of indebtedness

created by, any other corporation or corporations, and while owning said stock to exercise all the

rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote thereon;

(h) to purchase, sell and transfer shares of its own capital stock;

(i) to acquire, enjoy, utilize and to dispose of patents, copyrights, trademarks and any

licenses or other rights or interests therein and thereunder; and

in general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing and to have

and exercise all powers conferred by the laws of Florida upon corporations formed under the

general corporation acts of the State of Florida, and any amendments thereto, and to do any and

all things hereinbefore set forth to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.

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The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers; and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of special powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this Corporation.

ARTICLE IV Capital Stock

(a) The aggregate number of shares of capital stock authorized to be issued by this Corporation shall be 1000 shares of common stock with a par value of \$1.00 per share. Each share of said stock shall entitle the holder thereof to one vote at every annual or special meeting of the Stockholders of this Corporation. The consideration for the issuance of said shares of capital stock may be paid, in whole or in part, in cash, in other property (tangible or intangible) or in labor or services actually performed for this Corporation, at a fair valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors. When issued, all shares of stock shall be fully paid and nonassessable.

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(b) In the election of Directors of this Corporation, there shall be no cumulative voting of

the stock entitled to vote at such election.

ARTICLE V

Existence of Corporation

In accordance with Section 607.0203, Florida Statutes, the existence of this Corporation

shall commence on the date these Articles of Incorporation are subscribed to and acknowledged.

and execution. If filed after such five (5) days, the existence of this Corporation shall commence

upon the filing of these Articles by the Department of State. In either event, the existence of this

Corporation thereafter shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI

Registered Office and Registered Agent

The initial registered office of this Corporation shall be located at 2699 South Bayshore

Boulevard, Seventh Floor, Miami, Florida 33133; and the initial Registered Agent of this

Corporation at such office shall be Stephen P. Walroth-Sadurni, Esq. This Corporation shall have

the right to change such registered office and such registered agent from time to time, as provided

by law.

ARTICLE VII

Board of Directors

The Board of Directors of this Corporation shall consist of not less than one (1) nor more

than fifteen (15) members, the exact number of Directors to be fixed from time to time by the

Stockholders or the by-laws. The business and affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by the

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Board of Directors, which may exercise all such powers of this Corporation and do all such lawful acts and things as are not by law directed or required to be exercised or done only by the Stockholders. A quorum for the transaction of business at meetings of the Board of Directors shall consist of a majority of the number of Directors determined form time to time to comprise the Board of Directors, and, the acts of a majority of the Directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall constitute the acts of the Corporation.
