ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

NORTH FLORIDA SPECIALTY COATINGS, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is NORTH FLORIDA SPECIALTY COATINGS, INC.

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.


