ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

EARTHCARE LANDSCAPE SERVICES, INC.

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation for profit (the "Corporation") under the laws of the State of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is Earthcare Landscape Services, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office of the Corporation has not yet been determined. The mailing address of the Corporation is P.O. Box 600168, Jacksonville, Florida 32260.

ARTICLE III CAPITAL STOCK

- (a) <u>Authorized Shares</u>. The total number of shares of stock that the Corporation may issue is 100,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$0.10 per share. Each of the shares shall entitle the holder thereof to one (1) vote at any meeting of the shareholders. All or any part of the stock may be paid for in cash or in property at a fair valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors at a meeting called for such purpose. All stock, when issued, shall be fully paid and nonassessable.
- (b) <u>Capital Stock</u>. The capital of the Corporation shall be at least equal to the sum of the aggregate par value of all issued shares having par value plus such amounts as, from time to time, by resolution of the Board of Directors, may be transferred thereto.
- (c) <u>Corporate Liquidation and Dissolution</u>. In the event of voluntary or involuntary liquidation, dissolution or winding up of the Corporation, the holders of record of the common stock shall be entitled to receive distribution, ratably, of the remaining assets of the Corporation.
 - (d) <u>Preemptive Rights</u>. Shareholders shall have no preemptive rights.
 - (e) Cumulative Voting. Cumulative voting shall not be permitted.

(f) Restrictions on Transfer of Stock. The shareholders may, by bylaw provision or by a written shareholders' agreement, impose such restrictions on the sale, transfer, or encumbrance of the stock of the Corporation as they may see fit.

ARTICLE IV INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is One Independent Drive, Suite 2600, Jacksonville, Florida 32202, and the name of the initial registered agent of the Corporation at that address is Mary A. Robison.

ARTICLE VI DIRECTORS

- (a) <u>Number</u>. The Corporation shall have two directors initially. The number of directors may be changed from time to time pursuant to the bylaws adopted by the shareholders.

(c) <u>Indemnification</u>. The Board of Directors is specifically authorized to provide for indemnification of directors, officers, employees and agents to the fullest extent permitted by law.

The initial Bylaws of the Corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors. Bylaws shall be adopted, altered, amended or repealed from time to time by either the shareholders or the Board of Directors, but the Board of Directors shall not alter, amend or repeal any bylaw adopted by

ARTICLE VIII DURATION

The Corporation shall exist perpetually. Corporate existence shall commence on the date these Articles of Incorporation are executed and acknowledged, except that if they are not filed by the Department of State of the State of Florida within five (5) business days thereafter, corporate existence shall commence upon filing by the Department of State.
