ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

The undersigned incorporator for the purposes of forming a for-profit corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME:

The name of the corporation is **Blue Storm Enterprises, Inc.** The duration of the Corporation is perpetual. The effective date upon which this Corporation shall come into existence shall be the date these Articles are filed by the Secretary of State.
