The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a not for profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

FIRST COAST ATTORNEY'S REAL ESTATE COUNCIL, INC.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be **1919 Blanding Blvd., Jacksonville, FL 32210**. The mailing address for the corporation shall be **1919 Blanding Blvd., Jacksonville, FL 32210**.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed, and the business and objects to be carried on and promoted by it are as follows:

a. 
