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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COMMONS II INVESTORS, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is Commons II Investors, Inc. (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

That a Class A voting common stockholder is interested in a matter to be voted upon shall not disqualify him/her from voting thereon.
- (b) Except as otherwise provided by law, the entire voting power for the election of the directors and for all other purposes shall be vested exclusively in the holders of the outstanding Class A voting common stock.
- (c) With the exception of voting rights, each share of common stock shall have the same characteristics regardless of class.

ARTICLE VI- BYLAWS

The bylaws of the Corporation may be adopted, altered, amended or repealed by either the stockholders or the directors of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII - INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.
