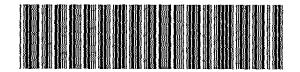

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF LAW OFFICE OF PENNY J. CREECH, P.A.

The undersigned hereby makes, subscribes, acknowledges and files with the operation of State of Florida these Articles of Incorporation in compliance with Chapter 607 and/or Chapter 621, Florida Statutes, for the purpose of forming a professional association (the "Corporation") for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be Law Office of Penny J. Creech, P.A.

ARTICLE II EXISTENCE OF CORPORATION

This corporation shall begin existence on the date of filing these Articles with the Secretary of State, Department of Corporations for the State of Florida and shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address and mailing address of the corporation's principal office is 727 West Princeton Street, Orlando, FL 32804. The corporation may change its principal office by filing with the Department of State of the State of Florida a statement complying with Section 607.0502, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE IV PURPOSE

The corporation may engage in the practice of law and the transaction of any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall have power:

- (a) To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at pleasure, and to use the same by causing it, or a facsimile thereof, to be impressed, and affixed, or in any other manner reproduced.
- (b) To purchase, take, receive, lease or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.
- (c) To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, create a security interest in, lease, exchange, transfer, and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
- (d) To lend money to, and use its credit to assist its officers and employees in accordance with Section 607.0833, Florida Statutes.
- (e) To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise own, hold vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in, and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, associations, partnerships or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or any other government, state, territory, governmental district, or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof.
- (f) To make contracts and guarantees and incur liabilities, borrow money as such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds, or other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of all or any of its property, franchises and income.
- (g) To lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, and to take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.
- (h) To conduct its business, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the power granted by this act within and without this state.
- To elect or appoint officers or agents of the corporation and define their duties and fix heir compensation.
- (j) To make and alter bylaws, not inconsistent with its Articles of Incorporation or with the laws of the State of Florida, for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the corporation.
- (k) To make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific or educational purposes.

- (1) To pay pensions and carry out pension plans, profit sharing plans, stock bonus plans, stock option plans, retirement plans, benefit plans, and other incentive and compensation plans for any and all of its directors, officers and employees.
- (m) To provide insurance for its benefit on the life of any of its directors, officers, or employees, or on the life of any shareholder for the purpose of acquiring, at death, shares of its stock owned by the shareholder or by the spouse or children of the shareholder.
- (n) To be a promoter, incorporator, general partner, limited partner, member, associate or manager of any corporation, partnership, limited partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise.
- (o) To have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect its purpose.

ARTICLE VI SHARES

- (a) The total number of shares of capital stock authorized to be issued by the corporation shall be one-hundred (100) shares having a par value of one (1) dollar per share. Each of the said shares of stock shall entitle the holder thereof to one (1) vote at any meeting of the stockholders. All or any part of said capital stock may be paid in cash, in property or in labor or services actually performed for the corporation and valued at a fair valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors at a meeting called for such purpose. All stock when issued shall be paid for and shall be non-assessable.
- (b) In the election of directors of this corporation there shall be no cumulative voting of the stock entitled to vote at such decision.

ARTICLE VII INITIAL OFFICERS/DIRECTORS

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be one (1) and the name and address of the person who is to serve as a member thereof is as follows:

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all the rights conferred upon the stockholders herein are subject to this reservation.
