However, an exception is made to the above in relation to matters as to which he shall be finally adjudged in such action, suit or proceeding to have been derelict in the performance of the duties imposed on him as such director. The right of indemnification herein provided shall not be exclusive of other rights to which any such person may now or hereafter be entitled as a matter of law.

ARTICLE XIV

This corporation elects to have preemptive rights. The shareholders of the corporation have a preemptive right, granted on uniform terms and conditions prescribed by the Board of Directors to provide a fair and reasonable opportunity to exercise the right, to acquire proportional amounts of the corporation's un-issued shares upon the decision of the Board of Directors to issue them.
