**AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
**OF**

**JOSEPH N. DE VERA, P.A.**

Pursuant to the provisions of Florida Statutes Sections 607.1006, 607.1007, 607.0704, 607.0821, and 621 of the Florida Business Corporation Act, the undersigned adopts the following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation (the "*Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation*") of **JOSEPH N. DE VERA, P.A.**, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida as filed on September 7, 2006 and assigned document number P06000115637, and confirms that such Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation was duly adopted by written consent of the sole shareholder on December 14, 2020. The number of votes cast for the amendment by the shareholder was sufficient for approval. These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation hereby amend and restate the provisions of the Corporation's original Articles of Incorporation in their entirety:

**ARTICLE I. NAME**

The name of the Corporation is JOSEPH N. DE VERA, INC. (the "*Corporation*").

**ARTICLE II. ADDRESS**

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is:

**ARTICLE III. TERM OF EXISTENCE**

The Corporation shall exist perpetually unless terminated sooner according to the laws of the State of Florida.

**ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Corporation is to engage in any lawful activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

**ARTICLES V. AUTHORIZED SHARES**

The number of shares the Corporation is authorized to issue is ten thousand (10,000), all of which have \$0.001 par value per share. One hundred (100) shares of the authorized common stock shall be designated as "Class A Voting Common Stock" and nine thousand nine hundred (9,900) shares of the authorized common stock shall be designated as "Class B Non-Voting Common Stock." The preferences, limitations and relative rights with respect to the Class A Voting Common Stock and the Class B Non-Voting Common Stock shall be the same, except that the holders of the Class B Non-Voting Common Stock shall not be entitled to vote on any matters required or permitted to be submitted to a vote by the Shareholders of the Corporation, except when otherwise required by the Florida Business Corporation Act, as amended.

**ARTICLE VII. AMENDMENTS**


