The undersigned subscribers, Thomas B. Smith and Richard David Potter, to these Articles of Incorporation, being natural persons competent to contract, desiring that they be incorporated for such purpose so hereby make, execute and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Ausmor Contracting, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The general powers of this corporation shall be as follows:

- A. All corporate powers as specifically set forth in Section 607.0302, Florida Statutes.
- B. To operate, conduct, carry on and engage in the construction business and any other business or businesses not prohibited by law.
- C. To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services of every class, kind and description; except that it is not to conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, insurance, surety, express, railroad, canal, telegraph, or cemetery company, a
