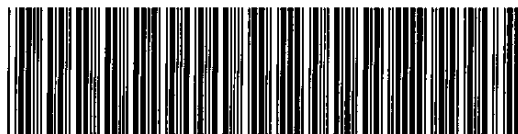

The undersigned incorporator(s), for the purpose of forming a corporation in compliance with Chapter 607 and/or Chapter 621, F.S. (Profit), hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be The Children's Country Club Corporation. The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE






