

### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

# Two Lefts Don't Make a Right Productions Inc.

The undersigned incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation for profit pursuant to the Florida Business Corporation Act, as particularly set forth in Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes.

# ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is Two Lefts Don't Make a Right Productions Inc.

### **ARTICLE II - NATURE OF BUSINESS**

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business, including but not limited to:

- (a) To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise, lands and interest in lands, and to own, hold, improve, develop and manage any real estate so acquired, and to erect, or cause to be erected, on any lands owned, held or occupied by the corporation, buildings or other structures, public or private, with their appurtenances and to manage, operate, lease, rent, rebuild, enlarge, alter or improve any buildings or other structures, now or hereafter erected on any lands so owned, held or occupied and to encumber or dispose of any lands or interests in lands and any buildings or other structures, at any time owned or held by the corporation. To buy, sell, mortgage, exchange, lease, hold for investment or otherwise, use and operate real estate of all kinds, improved or unimproved, and any right or interest therein.
- (b) To acquire by purchase, lease, manufacture, or otherwise, any personal property deemed necessary or useful in the equipment, furnishing or improvement, development or management of any property, real or personal, at any time owned, held or occupied by the corporation, and to invest, trade or deal in any personal property deemed beneficial to the corporation and to lease, rent, encumber or dispose of any personal property at any time owned or held by the corporation.
- (c) To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes or other evidences of indebtedness and to execute such mortgages, transfers or corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.
- (d) To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.

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- To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise (e) acquire or dispose of the shares of the common stock, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by another corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government and while owner of such stock, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.
- To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts and agreements of every kind for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association or corporation; and to transact any further and other business necessarily connected with the purposes of this corporation or calculated to facilitate the same.
- To carry on any or all of its operations and businesses and to promote its objects within the State of Florida or elsewhere, without restriction as to place or amount; and to have, use, exercise and enjoy all of the general powers of like corporations.
  - (h) To engage in any and all lawful businesses, trades, occupations and professions.
- To do any or all of the things herein set forth to the same extent as natural persons (i) and the world as principals, agents, contractors or otherwise, alone, or in company with others and to do and perform all other things and acts as may be necessary, where profitable or expedient in carrying on any of the business or acts named above.

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## ARTICLE III - COMMON STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is one thousand (1,000) shares of common stock, each having the par value of \$1.00.

Authorized common stock may be paid for in cash, services or property, at a just value to be fixed by the Board of Directors of this corporation at any regular or special meeting.

## **ARTICLE IV - OTHER STOCK**

The Board of Directors of this corporation is authorized to issue other shares of the corporation under such terms and conditions as said Board deems in the best interests of this corporation.

#### ARTICLE VI - ADDRESS

### **ARTICLE VII - DIRECTORS**

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## ARTICLE X- EFFECTIVE DATE

These Articles of Incorporation shall be effective and the corporation's existence shall begin when these Articles of Incorporation are acknowledged.

#### **ARTICLE XI - VOTING RIGHTS**

Except as otherwise provided by law, the entire voting power for the election of directors and for all other purposes shall be vested exclusively in the holders of the outstanding common shares.

## ARTICLE XII- BY-LAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal By-Laws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the Shareholders.
