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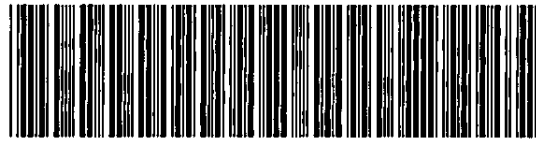



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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract and legally authorized to practice the profession of legal services to the public in the State of Florida, hereby proceeds to form a professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, and hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is TERRANCE A. JONES

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

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The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract and legally authorized to practice the profession of legal services to the public in the State of Florida, hereby proceeds to form a professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, and hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is TERRANCE A. JONES, P. A.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE AND NATURE OF BUSINESS

The purpose of the Corporation and the nature of its business are as follows:

1. To engage in the practice of legal services to the public as a professional service corporation and to provide services incident thereto to-wit:

A. To render the practice of legal services to the public in all other matters as allowed under the laws of the State of Florida for the practice of general law. This professional corporation shall exist and function in compliance with the "Florida Professional Service Corporation Act" (F.S.A Chapter 621) and in order to properly prosecute the objects and purposes above set forth, the Corporation shall have full power and authority to purchase, lease and otherwise acquire, hold, mortgage, convey and otherwise dispose of all kinds of property, both real and personal, necessary for the rendering of the service of the practice of legal services to the public .

2. To enter into contracts and carry on any activity necessary or incidental to the accomplishment or furtherance of the purpose of this Corporation.
3. The services of this Corporation that consist of the practice of legal services to the public shall be carried out only through officers, employees and agents who are licensed and in good standing in the State of Florida to render the service of legal services to the public .
4. To do everything necessary, proper or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes herein set forth, and to do every other act incidental thereto which is not forbidden by the laws of the State of Florida, or by the provision of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that the Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 500 shares having a par value of \$1.00 per share. Such shares shall be of a single class of common stock. None of the shares of the Corporation may be issued to anyone other than an individual who is duly licensed to practice legal services to the public by the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V - ADDRESS AND AGENT

The street address of the principal office of the corporation is 1835 East West Parkway, Suite #17, Orange Park, FL 32003, and the name of its initial registered agent is Terrance A. Jones, 1835 East West Parkway, Suite #17, Orange Park, FL 32003. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the office to any other address in the State of Florida and change the registered agent.

ARTICLE VI - DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors of at least one (1) director. No person shall serve as a Director of the Corporation unless the other person is duly licensed to practice legal services to the public in the State of Florida. The Directors shall be elected by the shareholders of the Corporation. The name and street address of each person who is to serve as a member of the initial Board of Directors is as follows:

ARTICLE VII - SUBSCRIBERS

ARTICLE VIII - RESTRAINT ON ALIENATION

No shareholder may sell or transfer his shares in the Corporation except to another individual who is eligible to be a shareholder the Corporation under Florida law.

ARTICLE IX - DISQUALIFICATION


If any officer, shareholder, agent or employee of the Corporation who has been rendering professional service to the public for the Corporation becomes legally disqualified to render such professional services within Florida or accepts employment that places

restrictions or limitations upon his or her continued rendering of such professional services, then the Corporation shall require him or her to comply with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act by severing all employment with and financial interest in the Corporation.

ARTICLE X - AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law.




