Article I

The name of the proposed corporation is: LINCO ALLOYS, INC.

The corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States of America and the State of Florida.

Article III

The maximum number of shares of stock which the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be 100 shares of common stock, with a par value of one dollar per share.

The amount of capital of which the corporation will begin business shall not be less than \$100.00 dollars.

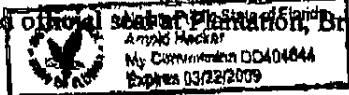
