#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

### VET MOBILE IMAGING CO-OP, Inc.

I, the undersigned, do hereby establish for the purpose of becoming a Corporation, operating on a cooperative basis for profit by and under the provisions of the statutes of Florida appertaining and providing for the formation, liabilities, rights, privileges and immunities of a Corporation operating for profit on a cooperative basis, and do hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of becoming such a Corporation for profit and do hereby declare, state and certify:

#### ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation shall be VET MOBILE IMAGING CO-OP, Inc.

#### ARTICLE II

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved as be directed by law.

#### ARTICLE III

The Corporation may transact any and all lawful business for which Corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act.

## ARTICLE IV

The maximum number of shares of stock that this Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time shall be one thousand (1,000) shares of common stock having a nominal or par value of one hundred dollar (100.00) per share.
